TO: Mandi Muncey, Clerk of the Town of Burlington: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to cause the voters of the Town of Burlington to be notified of the school budget validation referendum described in this warrant.

TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF BURLINGTON:

You are hereby notified that a school budget validation referendum meeting will be held at the Burlington Town Office, 1523 Long Ridge Road in the Town of Burlington on Thursday, June 10, 2021, for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1A: To elect a moderator to preside at the special town meeting.


Article 1: Do you favor approving the Burlington School Department budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the special town meeting on June 8, 2021?

The voting on Article 1 shall be by secret ballot referendum and the polls shall be opened immediately after the election of the moderator at 2:00 P.M. and closed at 7:00 P.M.

The Registrar of Voters shall hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name of address of the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.


