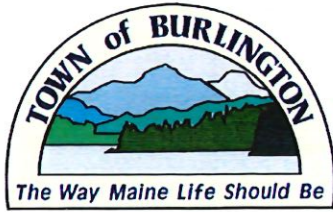

It was voted to discontinue the use of the town's backhoe at the BLT Station and to hire A&G Dirtworks on an hourly basis to provide equipment as requested to manage municipal waste flow.</i> <i>The town is waiting for a tentative date for the compactor installation.</i> <i>The town has been in possession of 2 snowmobiles that were given to the fire department. It was discussed and voted (3-0) to return them to the Burlington Back Country Riders Club. One Snowmobile has not been used for 4 years and has been stored at the Public Works Building. The 2nd sled is not in working order. They also began discussion on leasing the old fire station (public works garage) at 1500 Long Ridge Road to the Burlington Back Country Riders club to house trail groomers and other trail maintaining equipment. The annual cost of this property and liability insurance is currently \$398.00. The monthly power bill averages \$48.00 at this time. It is not currently being heated and there is no water.</i> <i>The board discussed possibly selling/putting up for bid, the 5-ton military truck that was given to the Burlington Fire Department by the Maine Forest Service.</i></p>
