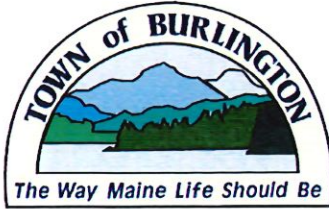

IV.	<p>SELECTMEN AGENDA: NEW BUSINESS: WARRANTS/BANK STATEMENTS GENERAL ASSISTANCE ORDINANCE A&G/LEASE WALL REPAIR/TRANSFER STATION COMPACTOR UPDATE</p> <p><i>The board signed and initialed the weekly warrants and the monthly bank statements.</i></p> <p><i>The board signed the amendment to adopt revisions to the General Assistance Maximums for the year beginning Oct. 1st, 2025 to Sept. 30th, 2026. A public meeting was held on Oct. 1st at the Municipal Building. A signed revision from the selectmen was sent to the state.</i></p> <p><i>A&G wants to renew the lease agreement to use the fire station building from November 1st, 2025 to April 30th, 2026. The board also voted 3-0 to hire A&G to plow the parking lot of the municipal buildings.</i></p> <p><i>The board discussed wall repair and installation of 40 ice guards on the roof of the transfer station.</i></p> <p><i>The projected date for the compactor installation at the transfer station is the 3rd week of Oct. 2025. Modified drawing measurements have been sent Atlantic recycling and returned.</i></p>
