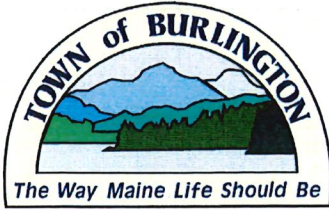

IV.	<p>SELECTMEN AGENDA: NEW BUSINESS: WARRANTS SCHOOL WARRANT MACHIAS SAVINGS BANK STATEMENTS DOT MEETING MILITARY TRUCK FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET UPDATED LABOR AND EQUIPMENT RATE</p> <p>The board viewed and initialed the weekly warrants and the Machias Savings Bank statements. They also signed the school warrant. Amount listed under Financial report.</p> <p>The selectmen discussed putting the 5-ton military truck on Marketplace. A motion was made and seconded to accept the motion. A vote was taken with a 3-0 vote to accept posting.</p> <p>A meeting is scheduled for March 12th, with Maine DOT road ranger and A&G Dirtworks to discuss possible improvements and better ways of putting down salt and sand.</p> <p>The town has received bids for the mowing of town cemeteries. The bids will be opened at the selectboard meeting on March 11th.</p> <p>The selectmen discussed the proposed budget for the Fire District. The long term lease for the Howland fire building is in the talking stage.</p> <p>The board voted 3-0 to accept the pay rate for the tax collector and town clerk from \$20.25 to \$20.85 instead of \$20.82 as previously voted.</p>
