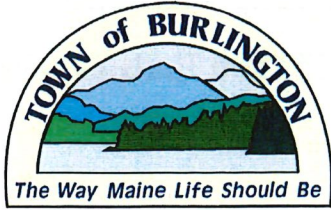

The selectmen are reviewing it.</p> <p>The board opened the bids for the mowing of town cemeteries. They are reviewing them and asking the bidders for additional information and clarifications.</p> <p>Requests for donations have been received. These requests will be in the Town report to be voted on by the residents at the annual town meeting. They are as follows:</p> <p><b>BURLINGTON FOOD PANTRY:</b> A request has been made for \$8,000.00. The board voted 3-0 to accept to raise/appropriate \$5,000.00</p> <p><b>HOWLAND REC. DEPARTMENT:</b> A request has been made for \$300.00. The board voted 3-0 to accept to raise/appropriate \$300.00</p> <p><b>HISTORICAL SOCIETY:</b> No dollar amount was requested. The board voted 3-0 to accept to raise/appropriate \$2,000.00</p> <p><b>EASTERN AGENCY ON AGING:</b> A request was made for \$450.00. The board voted 3-0 to accept to raise/appropriate \$450.00</p> <p><b>4TH OF JULY COMMITTEE:</b> A request was made for \$3,000.00 The board voted 3-0 to accept to raise/appropriate \$3,000.00.</p> <p><b>HOME INC.: (FAMILY AND HOUSING.)</b> A request was made for \$1.00 per resident which is \$373.00. The board voted 3-0 not to raise/appropriate this amount. The town has never used this program.</p>
