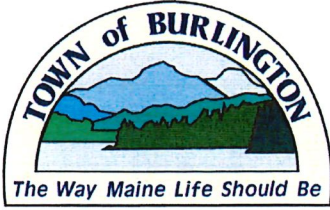

IV	NEW BUSINESS: WEEKLY TOWN WARRANT/BANK STATEMENTS BLT TRIAL BALANCE C&I BUILDERS BURLINGTON GENERAL STORE DAM ROAD CLOSURE WELL FIRE DISTRICT <i>The board reviewed and initialed the weekly town warrant and bank statements.</i> <i>The board reviewed the trial balance statement for the BLT as of July 31, 2026</i> <i>First selectman, John Smith, will meet with Cliff Sibley of C&I Builders to discuss repairs to the Transfer Station building and the town office building. Ice shields need to be installed at the BLT.</i> <i>Mark Ireland, owner of the Burlington General Store, attended the meeting to discuss the use of the playground field for parking for their 1-year celebration at the store on Oct. 10th.</i> <i>The board discussed a public hearing date for the closure of the Dam Road to winter maintenance.
