New Home / Dwelling / Seasonal Cottage Construction

Step 1Obtain Plumbing Permits (Need soil test, site plan and contact Plumbing Inspector)

Step 2Contact C.E.O. for Site Visit & Building Permit

Minimum fee of \$20.00

10 cents a square foot for unconditioned space (not heated or cooled).

20 cents a square foot for conditioned space

30 cents a square foot for Commercial/ Industrial space

Alterations / Renovations / Additions Construction

Step 1Obtain Plumbing Permit if Plumbing Involved

Step 2Call C.E.O. for Site Visit / Building Permit

All Other Construction – Sheds, Garages, Decks, Etc.

Step 1Check with C.E.O. other permits may not be required.

Building Permit Information

A Building Permit is required **before** beginning the construction, alteration, addition or the replacement of a building or part thereof which the proposed work is "100 square feet or more". The Landowner or Lessee, architect, contractor or builder employed by such owner or lessee shall obtain a Permit covering such proposed work unless otherwise excepted by the Town of Burlington Building Ordinance.

Construction and alteration activities on projects for which a permit has been granted shall be completed within 2 years of permit issue date.

Internal and External (septic system) permit is required prior to the construction of any new dwelling. See the Plumbing Inspector for applicable permits.

After the necessary Plumbing Permit has been obtained, call the C.E.O. for a Site visit to your property. Lot line(s) and road set back distances will be obtained at this time by the C.E.O. At this time a Building Permit may be issued if all other applicable permits have been obtained.

Additional special permits are required in the in the Shoreland Zone areas of Town. See either the Town Office or the C.E.O. for information.

A driveway culvert may be required at your Building Site. Check with the Town Office or C.E.O. for culvert information.

Building Permit Fees are as follows: A minimum of \$20.00 shall be charged for a building permit.

10 cents per square foot for unconditioned space (not heated or cooled).

20 cents a square foot for conditioned space.

30 cents a square foot for Commercial/Industrial space

Square footage shall be calculated by the dimensions of the structure for each floor.

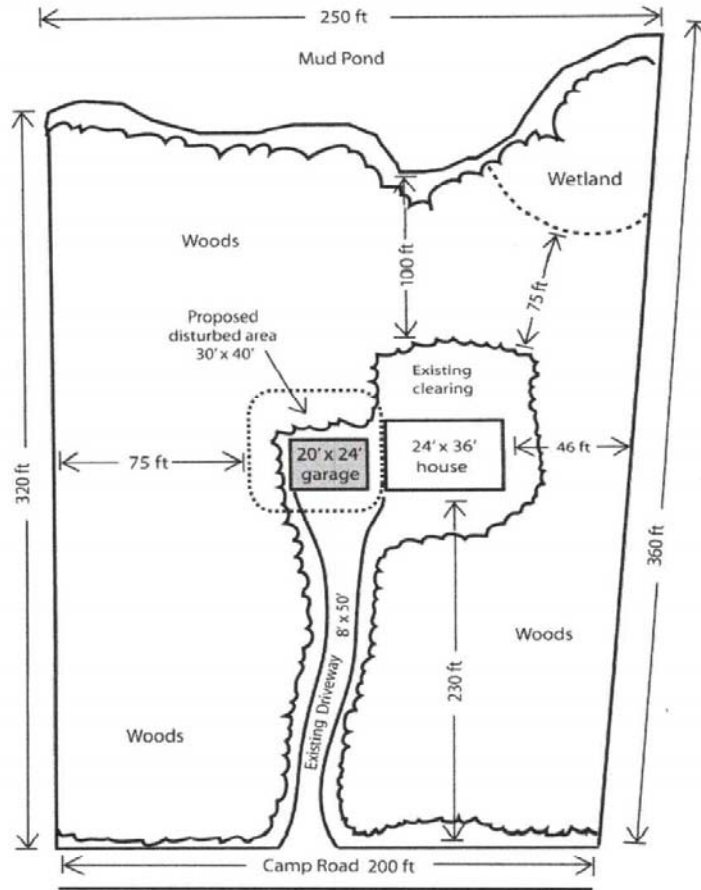


